Dress Code

“Comfortable”: Whatever is most comfortable for you. However, we do ask that ladies refrain from wearing shorts at any time while we are in Tanzania. Slacks are permissible under the Comfortable code.

“Casual/Skirts”: Casual clothing with ladies wearing calf or ankle length skirts.

“Sunday Best”: Dress for church. Ties not required for men but encouraged; coats optional.
