

Luggage Allowances and Restrictions

IMPORTANT: Restrictions regarding what can and cannot be contained in carry-on luggage are changing. New restrictions with regard to liquids are particularly strict. For current restrictions, please go to www.tsa.gov. Click on: **View Our Permitted and Prohibited Items**.

IMPORTANT: The information below regarding luggage weight and size was in effect as of 15 February, 2010. We will advise you as far in advance as possible of any changes.

CARRY-ON LUGGAGE: KLM will accept one carry-on item, with a maximum outside linear dimension of 45 inches (115 cm) and not more than 40 lbs (18kgs). This piece must be of a size and shape to fit under the seat in front of the passenger, or in an enclosed overhead compartment. In addition to the one piece of carry-on luggage, travelers may also carry a purse, briefcase or laptop computer. Luggage not meeting these specifications must be transported as checked luggage. Note that laptop computers must be removed and opened for inspection at security check-points.

CHECKED LUGGAGE: KLM will accept a total of two pieces of checked luggage, subject to maximum weight limitation, which is 50 lbs (23 kgs) per piece and not more than 62 linear inches (158 cm) per piece. Be very careful not to exceed the weight limit; additional pounds are charged at a very high rate. We recommend you keep your luggage at 45lbs. or less to account for differences in weighing scales.

USE NYLON STRAPS: It is a very good idea to use nylon straps on your luggage and not rely only on the luggage catches. **DO NOT LOCK** your checked luggage as all checked luggage is subject to search. You may also want to bring a collapsible bag to use as your second piece of luggage on the return trip for gifts you are bringing home.

LUGGAGE TAGS: Get good quality luggage tags (don't depend upon paper airline tags) and attach tags to *all* luggage pieces (including carry-ons). In addition to your home address and phone, include the following contact information:

Be sure you attach your luggage tag to something on your bag which cannot be accidentally torn off (e.g., fabric handles). Please remain in the check-in terminal until your luggage has cleared security. You may wish to print out and use the luggage tags below.

GROUP CHECK-IN: We will check in as a group, so please do not go through check-in before the entire group arrives. Please be on time for check-in.
