As you can see, our itinerary is a busy one! It often involves traveling significant distances or several hours at a time on game drives. On those "travel days" and during game drives, attention is paid to regular rest stops along the way. However, in some instances, we will need to ask our travelers to manage up to 3-4 hours between stops. On the evening before departure on any given day, we will inform travelers of the approximate time between rest stops on the following day.

Travel on Tanzanian roads can be dusty. This may be a problem both for those who have respiratory conditions as well as for sensitive electronic equipment. Dust masks will always be available in each safari car. Or, you may wish to bring your own. We suggest protective coverings for any sensitive electronics (cameras, mobile phones, etc.).
